Each Camping unit (tent, RV, tarps, large shelters) Must Have a Camping Permit. Each Electric fee pays for ONE outlet. A Single outlet may not be used by multiple Camping units.

Use of QUIET generators allowed only 8 am to 10 pm.

#### Campground Parking

Only Full Festival & 2-Day Ticket Holders can purchase Camping or Parking permits. Vehicles without permits must park in Long Term Parking or Day Parking.

Do Not Park in Fire Lanes or Roadways. Violators towed at your expense.

**Handicapped Camping & Parking:** Inquire at the Gate. <u>Only small</u> handicap-required mobility vehicles are allowed in the interior.




#### **Barry Patton**
